#### Renewable Generation Funds Grant Application Not-For-Profit Organization

#### **Application Instructions**

Please Type – applications filled out in pencil or ink will be returned! Filing application electronically is strongly encouraged.

#### Who is eligible to request assistance?

Not-for-profit Organizations that are current LPEA members residing within the LPEA's territory.

#### How do I apply for assistance?

Any not-for-profit organization requesting funds for local renewable generation projects can make an application to La Plata Electric Association. Forms are available by calling 970-382-3505, requesting via email – <u>jbennett@lpea.coop</u>, or located on LPEA's web site at www.lpea.coop.

#### What additional information should I include with my form?

In addition to filling out the form COMPLETELY, consider following these guidelines:

- Make a <u>specific</u> request, telling the board exactly how much money you request and how you intend to use the funds.
- Complete an LPEA Interconnection/Net Metering Application for the renewable generation project.
- LPEA Engineering Review results, if available at the time of application.
- Provide proof of easement or title to property where the renewable generation project will be installed.
- Identify all energy efficiency measures completed to the building in the last five years.
- List other sources of funding or assistance that are available to you; outline which sources you are pursuing, the amounts requested and any amounts already awarded.
- Any additional information you can supply in the form of a letter is extremely helpful to the board in making decisions regarding these requests.



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- All applications must include the organization's most <u>recent financial statement</u>, <u>budget (if available)</u>, and a copy of the organization's not-for-profit letter from the <u>IRS</u>.
- A five (5) minute presentation to LPEA's board of directors may be requested when considering your application.

#### When is the deadline for application submissions?

Renewable Generation Funds Grant Application time period will open on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 and should be received by December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019. Notification of acceptance or rejection of awards will be made in February 2020.

## Is an LPEA Engineering Review for the proposed Renewable Generation Project required?

An LPEA Engineer Review for the Renewable Generation Project is required in order to clearly understand the system impact and system requirements at a given location. This review can be conducted prior to completing this application or after the application is received by LPEA, but it must be completed prior to the awarding of the grant.

#### Is there a limit to the amount I can request?

<u>Be aware there are limited funds available each year</u>. LPEA anticipates awarding approximately \$36,000 in grants annually and typically award grants up to \$18,000. Grants may be awarded to partially fund projects based upon matching funds and preference will be given to projects with 100% (1 to 1) matching.
